Record date and time
Take photos and videos of agents,
vehicles, and license plates


KNOW YOUR RIGHTS

- **Do not open the door**
Talk through a window or the closed door. Immigration agents need a warrant **signed by a judge** or your permission to enter or search your home, car, or person
- **If they say they have a warrant**
Don't open the door yet. Have them pass it under the door or show it to you through a window while you call a lawyer
- **Don't answer questions**
Don't sign anything
Say out loud that you will not answer questions or sign any documents without a lawyer present
- **Take photos, videos, and/or notes**
Inform the officer you will be using your right to record. Take photos, record the interaction, and write down the details
- **If you aren't home, ask if you're free to leave**
If they say yes, leave calmly

What you can do

- Wear your whistle around your neck
- Teach family & neighbors the codes
- Use it when you see ICE
- Protect each other, always
